

CLHG: Staff appointments

Elzabe de Jager has been appointed general manager of City Lodge Hotel Fourways with effect from 1 December 2020. She began her career journey with the City Lodge Hotel Group 19 years ago as a receptionist at City Lodge Hotel Johannesburg, Barbara Road and has gleaned valuable experience in all aspects of the group's diverse operations.
