"The objective of the competition is to identify potentially profitable technologies and disruptive startups for virtual incubation and Aaceleration, with the intention of building AFGRI's innovation capacity and to foster support for and growth of South Africa's entrepreneurs," says ATS MD Niki Neumann.

The competition is open primarily to UP and Gordon Institute of Business Science students, as well as academic staff and alumni. "ATS will be actively participating in the competition by helping to validate entry concepts and providing a degree of mentoring to relevant startups in the fintech, foodtech and agtech spaces."
