

## New super-luxury Range Rover SUV set to arrive in 2021

The fifth generation Range Rover is set to be released in 2021, taking on the likes of the new Rolls-Royce Cullinan, the Bentley Bentayga, as well as the BMW X8 and Audi's secret SUV Q9 flagship.

According to <u>Autocar</u>, the all-new Range Rover will feature technically advanced powertrains, autonomous driving systems and an infotainment, to give it the edge over its rivals.

The new model will reportedly have 'significantly lighter' architecture, to allow for the extra heft of battery packs for hybrid and electric models.

The interior will have an updated version of the Touch Pro Duo system featuring two 10-inch screens that can be used simultaneously.

It will also have an advanced version of the Jaguar E-Pace's Smart settings, which uses artificial intelligence to monitor occupant's habits and adjust settings accordingly. It may also feature advanced autonomous driving systems and connected car technology which will allow drivers to unlock front doors, switch on lights, and even turn on TVs while driving.
