

Historical CT hotel to be refurbished as luxury apartments

Romney Park, a former five-star hotel, sited on the lower slopes of Signal Hill in Green Point, Cape Town is earmarked for refurbishment to modernise the interior and turn accommodation into sectional title apartments.



The 26 north-facing apartments will go on sale during late 2018. Units available for purchase will include ten one-bedroom, nine two-bedroom, four three-bedroom and three deluxe apartments, ranging in total size from 51-526m².

Interior designer Christo Koegelenberg, who has over 19 years of experience in the art of interior décor in South Africa and the United Kingdom, will be working in conjunction with MLH Architects, a firm known for its work in the heritage and urban design fields.
