

Spontaneous dining-out app launches in Cape Town

A new app, Feastfox, offers Capetonians the ability to book spontaneously at a lineup of over 60 top eating and drinking spots, including the likes of Reuben's, Kyoto Gardens Sushi, La Boheme, Nobu, Culture Club Cheese, Clarke's, Hokey Poke, Scheckter's Raw and Shio.



The service has been designed to make last minute restaurant or bar reservations a breeze. App users can discover new spots on the slick map and image view and make their choice without the hassle of phoning around or waiting for booking confirmation.

Co-founder and Cape Town local, Stuart Murless explains, "With a busy lifestyle, I never had time to plan ahead and make bookings. I wanted something that fits into the way I eat out, which is generally on impulse. With Feastfox, we are moving from the traditional 'book now, eat later' concept to 'book now, eat now'. This way you can go from craving to feasting with the click of a button."

The launch area includes the CBD, V&A Waterfront, De Waterkant, Green Point, Sea Point, Gardens, Vredehoek & Tamboerskloof. The Feastfox app is available for <u>iOS</u> and <u>Android</u>.
